Program Articulation between the Computer Science Pathway Program and the Bachelor of Science in Cyber Security

A student who completes the Computer Science Pathway Program from Butler Community College will be accepted with junior standing at Friends University in the Bachelor of Science in Cyber Security degree program within the College of Graduate and Professional Studies.

The following understandings apply:

- a) Butler Community College (BCC) programs are fully articulated to Friends University and the transfer of courses articulated remains current with BCC and Friends University cyber programs.
- b) A minimum of 43 credit hours of general education including a course in religion are required at Friends University to earn a bachelor's degree.

Students will complete credit hours at BCC in association with this agreement. Up to fifty-nine credit hours will be completed at Friends University. Students who transfer to Friends University from Butler Community College who have not completed the CS Pathway will have a program of study developed based on the remaining courses needed to degree completion.
