SINGING QUAKERS AS ADVOCATES

Choral music has been at the heart of the Friends University experience from the university's inception in 1898, and since 1924 the Friends University Singing Quakers have represented this tradition at home and abroad. During its nearly 100 year history, this choir has brought the finest in choral music throughout the United States, Europe, New Zealand, Australia, Costa Rica, and Canada. The choir has also appeared at the White House and in Lincoln Center in New York City. The Singing Quakers have continued to advocate for music not only through travelling, and appearing on local and national television, but also through educational outreach. They have held joint concerts with local high schools, choral exchanges on regional recruitment tours every spring break, and choral festivals such as the Sing It! Vocal Festival and All-State Prep Day.

VOCAL MUSIC AT FRIENDS

Friends University degree programs are designed to nurture students' passion for music, and to prepare for vocations in education,

performance and ministry. Generous vocal scholarships are awarded on the basis of audition to majors as well as non-majors. The

Friends University Division of Fine Arts offers degrees in music, art, music theatre, and theatre. Dedicated mentor-teachers, exposure to world-class guest artists and national and international travel are the hallmarks of a comprehensive program, which

includes individual applied lessons, participation in choral ensembles and performance in musical theater and opera productions. Four choirs, Singing Quakers, Concert Choir, Women's Choir, and Falcon Chorus perform a wide variety of music ranging from standard choral literature to vocal jazz to choral-orchestral masterworks.

BIOGRAPHIES

RAYVON T.J. MOORE

Dr. Moore became the Director of Choral Studies and Conductor of the Singing Quakers in 2020. He is the Artistic Director and Conductor of the Wichita Chamber Chorale and the Director of Music Ministries at Chapel Hill United Methodist Church.

Rayvon specializes in topics on conducting gesture, programming, and musical interpretation. Being a versatile performer, he has sung back up for The Rolling Stones, Barry Manilow, Patti Austin, Andrea Bocelli, Kathleen Battle and Deborah Voigt. Moore can be heard on the album "John Williams & Steven Spielberg: The Ultimate Collection" recorded with Sony Classical.

He has held faculty positions at Colgate University, Hamilton, NY; Hobart and William Smith Colleges, Geneva, NY; The Young Musicians Foundation, Los Angeles, CA; The Saturday Conservatory of Music, Pasadena; CA and Esperanza Azteca Youth Orchestra of Los Angeles. He has also served as Associate Conductor of the Eastman-Rochester Chorus and Chorale, Assistant Conductor for California State University Fullerton's Opera, Concert Choir and Women's Choir, as well as the Assistant Conductor of the Donald Brinegar Singers.

Moore holds a Bachelor of Arts in Choral Music degree from the University of Southern California, a Master of Music in Choral Conducting degree from California State University, Fullerton, and a Doctor of Musical Arts degree in Conducting from the Eastman School of Music.

CINDY BLASDEL

Cindy received the Bachelor of Music degree in Piano Performance from Friends University and the Master of Music degree in Piano Accompanying from Wichita State University. At Friends University, Blasdel has taught music theory, piano improvisation and vocal jazz. She was named a Who's Who Teacher in 2005 and received the Friends University Jan Lafever Adjunct Teaching Award in 2006.
