Nick also maintains a busy trumpet career freelancing with

professional groups in Central Kansas and is the principal trumpet of the Hutchinson Symphony.

Some of the acts Dr. Schroeder has appeared with are the World Famous Glenn Miller Orchestra, The Temptations, The Four Tops, Frankie Avalon, Fred Wesley, Spoon, The Rat Pack, The Guy Lombardo Orchestra, The Les Elgart Orchestra, The Champaign/Urbana Symphony Orchestra, Salina Symphony, The Box Tops, The Buckinghams, Marvin Hamlisch, Monica Mancini, Paul Carma, and aboard Carnival Cruise Lines. Dr. Schroeder can be found most weekends playing trumpet for Newspring Church or with the salsa group Tumbao in Wichita. Nick is an avid cyclist, chef, gardener, husband, and father of two beautiful girls, Lucy and Lily.
